Dr. Maxey L. Wellman received her DVM degree from The Ohio State University in 1978. She completed an internship in Small Animal Medicine and Surgery at Cornell University in 1979. She received her MS degree from the University of Illinois in 1981, and her PhD from the Ohio State University in 1987.

She has been on the faculty of The Ohio State University since 1981, first as an instructor and then an Assistant Professor. Currently, she is a Professor in the Department of Veterinary Biosciences and Service Head of Clinical Pathology.

Dr. Wellman is a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists (Clinical Pathology), a past President of the American Society for Veterinary Clinical Pathology and a current President of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists.

Dr. Wellman's areas of interest are mechanisms of feline leukemia virus-induced erythroid aplasia, structure and function of the bone marrow microenvironment, characterization of canine large granular lymphocytes, development of cell lines for characterization and therapeutic trials, and hematopoietic neoplasia.
